WHEREAS, opportunities for citizens with developmental disabilities to function as independently and productively as possible must be fostered in our community; and


WHEREAS, we encourage all citizens to support opportunities for individuals with developmental disabilities in our communities that include full access to education, housing, employment and recreational activities.
