Thank you for participating as a Family Partner in our Medical Home project. Without family partners like you, we cannot improve the quality of our practice. Here is a list to give you an idea of what to expect as a family partner.

### COMMUNITY

Be an advocate for your child and ALL Children and Youth with Special Healthcare Needs (CYSHCN) in your community. Do community outreach. Where are some places you can reach out to the community?

### MEETINGS

Participate in monthly (or bi-monthly) **team meetings** with your site.  
Participate in 1 monthly **phone call**.  
Attend 3 **Learning Collaboratives** per year.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

Share your **opinions** with your team.  
Provide **insight** on what quality care would be to you.  
**Advocate** for your child, other CYSHCN, and families with CYSHCN.  
**Attendance** at all meetings and trainings.

### REIMBURSEMENTS

\$20 per monthly **team meeting** you attend, up to \$40 per month  
\$20 per monthly **phone call** you participate in  
\$150 per **Learning Collaborative**  
**Travel Reimbursements** for attending Learning Collaboratives  
**Per Diem\*** and **Hotel\*** for attending Learning Collaboratives
